

## The rules of remineralization

The formation of a carious lesion is not an immediate or unpredictable event: different pre-cavitation stages in fact precede the cavitated stage. Knowing how to recognize these phases allows the dentist and the hygienist to implement a series of interventions aimed to arrest the lesion progression, and, in selected cases, its remineralization.

In the course of the presentation, with the help of many videos, we will retrace the cornerstones of carious disease, the diagnostic criteria for early diagnosis of pre-cavitation stages, and remineralizing strategies of more recent design.
