Currently divides his time between his family Dental Clinic in Sao Paulo-Brazil and the Digital Smile Design headquarters in Madrid-Spain. He is the Director of the DSD Residency program with continuing education courses for dental professionals from all over the world. Also works as a consultant for Dental companies and offices, developing products, implementing concepts and marketing strategies.

He has lectured and published internationally in the fields of esthetic dentistry, dental photography, oral rehabilitation, dental ceramics and implants.
