I am pleased to present the program of our next Annual Congress to be held in Bologna from 4 to 6 May 2023. The title of this Congress is **STRATEGIES**, **Restorative Strategies**: **Indications**, **Clinical Protocols and Longevity**. This title because today more than ever it is important to define precise clinical indications to the different types of adhesive and conservative ristorative treatment, clear indications as to which clinical protocols are most effective for achieving a Dentistry of excellence and which, in the light of clinical experience and literature, are the data on the longevity of adhesive restorations that we can now offer patients. Each single presentation will focus on these three points, addressing different themes.

The Congress will begin with the pre-congress Course on Thursday 4 May with the theme **Exploring the limits: foundations and long-term controls for minimally invasive complex rehabilitations,** with two international experts of the highest level such as Daniel Edelhoff and Oliver Brix who will guide us in what is minimally invasive dentistry on complete and complex rehabilitations both from a clinical and a dental point of view.

The Speakers who will alternate on the Congress podium are mainly AIC Active Members with the exception of some international guests. Adamo Monari, Salvatore Scolavino, Stefano Piccinelli, Tony Rotondo, Daniel Edelhoff, Oliver Brix, Andrea Polesel, Daniele Rondoni and Marco Veneziani will guide us in the different strategies of the different types of restorations. In this 24th Congress we will also have the pleasure of starting a series aimed at modern scientific evidence in Conservative and Adhesive Restoration, having for the first time a space dedicated to the AIC Review column, which will be coordinated by Lorenzo Breschi, in which a scientific update will be carried out on different types of treatments and restorative approaches.

In this event we would like also to cultivate synergy with the other restorative figure par excellence, which is the dental technician, to speak more and more a common language in adhesive prostheses. For this reason, in addition to having almost all the sessions in common, we have organized a seminar dedicated to Dental Technicians on Friday 5 May morning.

In the post-Congress we will have the opportunity, thanks to a collaboration with **SCAD** (Society for Color and Appearance in Dentistry), American Scientific Society of Aesthetics with particular focus on

colour, to have a seminar with International Speakers on the themes of shade taking and interpretation, and of color realization in Dentistry and Dental Technology. As always we will have several appointments to complete the cultural and playful moments of this experience together, such as Lunch & Learn, which have been so successful in past editions, Business Workshops fundamental to have a link in daily practice, AIC Tomorrow space dedicated to AISO Students, and, to complete the cultural experience, unique aggregative moments such as the Congress Party and the Run&Walk.

All this is done to live in a global and complete way what the experience of the AIC family is and an update of the highest level with human relationships and interaction among selected Colleagues. A heartful thanks to the Board of Directors, to the AIC Working Committees that conceived and developed this congressional theme, to the Secretariat of MJ Eventi that made all this possible from an organizational point of view, to the Sponsors who support and are part of this path and, finally, to the Speakers who have accepted with great enthusiasm to give life to this unique program. The whole family of Active Members and Ordinary Members is looking forward to meeting in this unique weekend of professional growth and intense personal relationships.

Travel to and within Bologna

Bologna is easy to reach. There are various airlines that fly directly to Bologna as well as excellent train connections from the major cities in Italy. In case your preferred airline does not offer direct flights to Bologna we recommend to book a flight to Milan and then take the direct train to Bologna. The highspeed railway connection is fast and the tickets well-priced.

By plane Guglielmo Marconi International Airport, 15 minutes by bus from the city centre, links Bologna with the main Italian and European airports. The airport is located just a few minutes from the city centre, served by taxi and a special bus line called the Aerobus which stops outside the main terminal building.

By train Due to its central location and geography, Bologna has emerged as the main rail transport hub of northern Italy, making it very well connected with other major Italian cities. The train is a very common means of transport. The high speed railway line is available to/from Milan, shortening the journey to 65 minutes. Bologna is also 35 minutes from Florence, 2 hours 20 minutes from Rome, 2 hours from Venice, 1 hour from Ferrara, etc.
