We strongly recommend that you get in touch with the Secretariat **as early as possible** to ensure sufficient time for visa processing.

#### Needs / disabled delegates

The **Congress Centre** is fully committed to ensuring accessibility and comfort for all delegates and speakers.

The venue works in consultation with accessibility specialists who regularly assess facilities and provide guidance on compliance with current disability regulations and standards.

- Access and Mobility: Raised step treads are provided outside the building to assist blind and partially sighted delegates. Entrance ramps are available for wheelchair users.
- Lifts: All lifts accommodate standard wheelchairs and feature low-level control panels and voice announcements.
- Conference Hall: The main hall includes a ramped entrance for wheelchair users and an additional ramp providing direct access to the stage and podium.
- Doorways and Facilities: All doorways are wide enough to accommodate standard wheelchairs. Accessible toilets are located on the lower ground floor.

**Wheelchairs** for visitors can be booked in advance by contacting the **Organising Secretariat**. Please note that assistance with wheelchair use cannot be provided.

If you require access for a **larger-sized wheelchair**, please inform the Secretariat **prior to your visit** so that suitable arrangements can be made.

#### **Time zone**

Bologna is located in the Central European Time Zone (CET), which is 1 hour ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+1).





#### Travel to and within Bologna

Bologna remains one of the easiest Italian cities to reach and explore. It is well connected by air, train, and road, with efficient transport options both to and within the city.

#### By plane

**Guglielmo Marconi International Airport (BLQ)** is located about 6 km from the city centre and offers numerous direct connections with major Italian and European cities. The airport can be reached from the centre in **about 15–20 minutes** by taxi or public transport.

- Marconi Express (People Mover): A fast, automated monorail that connects the airport to Bologna Centrale railway station in just 7 minutes. Trains run every 7–10 minutes. A one-way ticket costs around €11.
- Taxi: The average fare from the airport to the city centre is €18-25, depending on time of day and traffic.

#### By train

Thanks to its central position, Bologna is one of Italy's main railway hubs. **Bologna Centrale station** is served by high-speed trains (Trenitalia and Italo) connecting it efficiently with all major cities. Trains run frequently throughout the day, and tickets can be easily booked online through the main rail operators. Getting around Bologna

The city centre is compact and largely pedestrian-friendly. Most major sights are within walking distance.
