MINIMUM INTERVENTION ORAL CARE (MIOC) & MINIMALLY INVASIVE DENTISTRY (MID) - DEEP CARIES MANAGEMENT S3 GUIDELINES

In his lecture, Prof Banerjee from King's College London will define minimum intervention oral care (MIOC) and minimally invasive dentistry (MID). He will then describe the outcomes from the recently published EFCD-ESE-ORCA S3 level guidelines for deep caries management. These are pragmatic guidelines that can be used in clinical practice to deliver better caries management for patients.

Dr. Benerjee is Professor of Cariology and Operative Dentistry at King's College London and Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Guy's & St Thomas' Hospitals Foundation Trust (London). He holds three international honorary professorships and serves as a member of the Board of Trustees of the UK Oral & Dental Research Trust and the Oral Health Foundation.

In the United Kingdom, he holds several prominent national roles, including Honorary Consultant to the Office of the Chief Dental Officer (England), President of the British Society of Oral & Dental Research (2025–2027), Chair of the Faculty of Dentists at the College of General Dentistry (2024–2027), and Editor-in-Chief of the British Dental Journal Portfolio.

He has received major international awards, including the William H. Bowen Caries Research Distinguished Scientist Award (IADR, 2022) and the John Tomes Medal of the British Dental Association (2024). Author of five internationally recognized textbooks and more than 185 peer-reviewed scientific publications (H-index 57), and supervisor of 50 PhD and Master's students, he is internationally regarded as a leading authority in cariology and minimally invasive dentistry.
