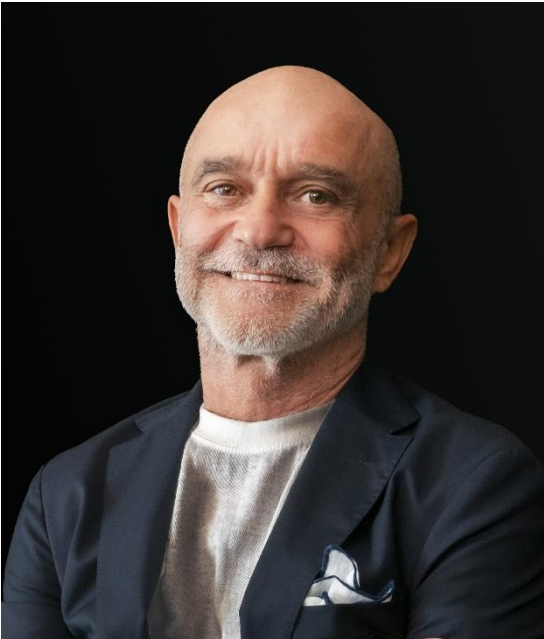
PERIO-RESTORATIVE INTERFACE ON TEETH AND IMPLANTS

CARLO MONACO



Carlo Monaco is an Associate Professor at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, where he directs the Master's program in Prosthodontics and Implant Prosthodontics at the Department of Surgery, Medicine and Dentistry. He graduated in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics from the University of Bologna in 1992 and carried out research activities within the Divisions of Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics and Maxillofacial Rehabilitation at the same university. He later spent three years at the Division of Cariology at the University of Geneva as part of a doctoral program and was invited as a visiting researcher by Prof. Ivo Krejci. He obtained a Master's degree and a PhD in Dental Materials from the University of Siena, as well as an additional PhD focused on zirconia-based materials from the University of Bologna. He is the author of more than 80 scientific publications and book chapters, serves as a reviewer for international journals, and has lectured in numerous courses and conferences in Italy and across Europe. Over the past twenty years, together with Prof. Giovanni Zucchelli, he has developed new clinical approaches exploring the relationship between dental materials, periodontology, and implantology, with particular attention to aesthetics.

Professor Giovanni Zucchelli, DDS, PhD, was a full professor of periodontology and implantology at the University of Bologna and served as President of the Italian Academy of Osseointegration. He is an associate editor of the *International Journal of Esthetic Dentistry* and serves on the editorial boards of numerous journals. He has received several awards, including the E. Bud Tarrson Research Award from the American Academy of Periodontology Foundation in Oral Plastic Surgery. He has been named an honorary member of the American Academy of Periodontology and received an honorary doctorate from the University of Buenos Aires (Argentina). He is an adjunct professor at the University of Bern. He is the author of over 160 articles and the bestseller *Mucogingival Esthetic Surgery* (Quintessence, 2013), published in 12 languages, and co-author of two illustrated textbooks as well as the chapter "Mucogingival Therapy—Periodontal Plastic Surgery" in *Clinical Periodontology and Implant Dentistry* (Wiley-Blackwell, 2015). He has recently published the textbook *Mucogingival Esthetic Surgery around Implants* (Quintessence), already translated into eight languages.
