Needs / disabled delegates

The **Congress Centre** is fully committed to ensuring accessibility and comfort for all delegates and speakers.

The venue works in consultation with accessibility specialists who regularly assess facilities and provide guidance on compliance with current disability regulations and standards.

- **Access and Mobility:** Raised step treads are provided outside the building to assist blind and partially sighted delegates. Entrance ramps are available for wheelchair users.
- **Lifts:** All lifts accommodate standard wheelchairs and feature low-level control panels and voice announcements.
- **Conference Hall:** The main hall includes a ramped entrance for wheelchair users and an additional ramp providing direct access to the stage and podium.
- **Doorways and Facilities:** All doorways are wide enough to accommodate standard wheelchairs. Accessible toilets are located on the **lower ground floor**.

Wheelchairs for visitors can be booked in advance by contacting the **Organising Secretariat**. Please note that assistance with wheelchair use cannot be provided.

If you require access for a **larger-sized wheelchair**, please inform the Secretariat **prior to your visit** so that suitable arrangements can be made.
